Notice is hereby given that Dakota Plains Legal Services (DPLS), a non-profit legal aid organization, will be holding an election vote for the position of client board member to sit on the DPLS Board of Directors. The mission of DPLS is to promote equal access to justice and improve the lives of our low-income clients through quality legal assistance. The DPLS Board of Directors is responsible for setting program policy and insuring compliance with all federal regulations governing the operation of Dakota Plains Legal Services. The client board member will represent the interests of the Oglala Sioux of the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation and its members.

Serving on the DPLS Board of Directors has an expectation of attendance of four meetings a year. Candidates will be paid to attend, reimbursed for travel, provided a hotel room and per diem for food. There is also an expectation of time dedication outside of the meetings.
